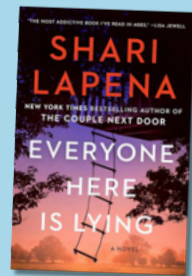

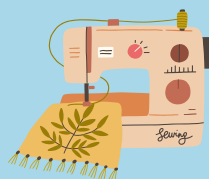

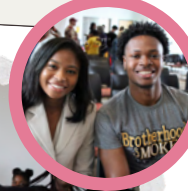
Paint Night at the Weaver Bolden Branch
